

1811 Will of Eleanor Hungerford

In the name of God Amen I Eleanor Hungerford of Calvert County do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows to wit -

Imprimus I give and bequeath to my son Jesse Hungerford my negro men Peter and Porringer Negro woman Poll and her two chidren Frisby and Moses likewise a negro boy called Baruch two other negro boys Joe and Augustus one best bed and best furniture one desk one dozen chairs one set consisting of three Mahogany Tables - [>p.4]

Item I give to my son William E. Hungerford one Negro man called Will and a bed and furniture -

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Turner one Negro woman called Rousby Hall Poll-

Item I give to my Daughter Mary Hungerford one negro woman named Priss -

Item I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Ireland Hungerford one negro man called Sam -

Item I give to my Daughter Eleanor Hungerford one negro woman called Mannor Jinny & her child

Item I give to my child Thomas Bourne Hungerford one Negro man called Nace -

Item I give to my son Jesse one Negro girl called Eliza -

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah one bed and furniture

Item I give to my Daughter Mary one bed and furniture

Item I give to my Dughter Elizabeth one bed and furniture

Item I give to my son Thomas one bed and furniture

Item The Residue of my estate after the payment of my Debts I give two thirds to my son Jesse and the other one third to be equally divided amongst all the rest of my children - In testimony where I have here unto set my hand and seal this seventh day of Sptember eighteen hundred and Eleven -
